**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made

**Post Dated Checks and Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

## Notice to Exhibitors

**Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.

**Each Owner and Agent** listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

**As Specified in Chapter 12, Section 4** of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

**Dogs May Arrive** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

**Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding up a Class.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

**All Dogs Present** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**Class Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**No gasoline or diesel generators** are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

## **Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries**

**Stud Dog Class-** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class for his Variety, and must appear in the ring with at least one, but not more than four of his get. The get need not necessarily be of the same Variety as the Stud Dog. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of Get. **Entry fee is \$12.00 for the Brood Bitch as a first entry or as an additional class.**

**Brood Bitch Class** –The same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the judge’s decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the classes will be will be eligible for Best of Variety by virtue of having won these classes. **Entry fee is \$12.00 for the Brood Bitch as a first entry or as an additional class.**

**Brace Class-** For two dogs of the same Variety and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The dogs comprising the Brace **MUST** be named at the time of the entry and must be entered in another class at this show. Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes – “Brace Class”. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** Brace must be so designated, i.e. Brace #1, Brace #2, etc. **Entry fee is \$12.00 per Unit.**
